WHAT IS A CHROMEBOOK?

- A laptop that runs Google's Chrome operating system and Chrome Web browser. Providing a total Web-based operating environment, all applications are downloaded from the Web, and although an Internet connection is mandatory, <u>some apps may run offline as well</u>. Chromebooks boot up fast and require minimal user configuration.
- They also come with Google's office suite (see Google Docs). See Chrome OS and Chrome browser.

CHROMEBOOK KEYBOARD DIFFERENCES

Use your Chromebook keyboard

Your Chromebook keyboard works just like a regular keyboard, with a few differences.

Unique keys on your Chromebook keyboard

- Search your apps and the web To turn Caps Lock on or off, press **Alt** + **Search**.
- Go to the previous page in your browser history (F1)
- Go to the next page in your browser history (F2)
- C Refresh your current page (F3)
- Hide the tabs and launcher in full-screen Immersive mode (F4)
- Show all windows in Overview mode (F5)
- Dim the screen (F6)
- Make the screen brighter (F7)
- Mute (F8)
- Lower the volume (F9)
- Raise the volume (F10)

HOW MUCH DOES A CHROMEBOOK COST?

- As little as \$99 (last Black Friday special) to as much as \$1000 for a high end machine with an Intel I7 processor.
- Average prices new can be \$180 and up.
- An <u>excellent</u> way to start out is to buy a refurbished machine that has come off lease from a school. Royal Computers has machines that they have supported for local school districts. Pay attention to the condition grade, A, B, or C, used in some ads.


DRAWBACKS OF A CHROMEBOOK

- Chromebooks don't support Java based websites
- Projecting to an LCD can be different on each device
- Limited onboard storage, (16GB), but also Drive online.
- No legacy apps like Word, Excel, PowerPoint etc. but Google Drive Apps are available.
- Printing can be problematic SOMETIMES.
- Each update of the Chrome OS makes these issues diminish.


OFFLINE GOOGLE APPS

- Google Calendar- calendar and schedule
- Google Documents- Edit and View Docs
- Google Presentations- Edit and View Presentations
- Google Spreadsheets- create and view when using Google Sheets
- Google Drawing- Edit and View Drawings


CHROME DESKTOP START SCREEN




CHROME BROWSER WINDOW

Some Chrome OS Quick Tips

- <u>Save to Drive instead of Files-</u> Settings > Show Advanced Settings > Downloads > Change > Google Drive > New folder
- Enable Screen Magnifier- Settings > Show Advanced Settings > Accessibility > Enable Screen Magnifier. Use Ctrl+Alt and two fingers scrolling up and down on the trackpad to activate. Screen zooms to cursor position.
- <u>Caps Lock on a Chromebook-</u> Press Shift + Search to activate caps lock on a Chromebook. Press the same keys again to deactivate it. Or, go to Settings > Device > Keyboard Settings > where you can make either the Ctrl, Alt or Search key a permanent Caps Lock key.
- <u>Taking Screenshots-</u> To take a full screen screenshot press Ctrl + . To capture a select area of the screen Ctrl + Shift + . Use the built-in photos app to crop and adjust.
