
Alexa, set a timer for 15 minutes. Alexa set an alarm for 7:00 AM. Alexa, what's my flash briefing? Alexa, good morning.

Want to play music on an Echo in another room? Now with multi-room music, you can set up an audio group in the Alexa App and play music across your Echo devices. Tell Alexa to play jazz in the kitchen, top pop in the family room, or play the same song throughout your whole home. Learn more.

Keep your household in sync


Now there's an easier way to quickly get your family on the same page. Say "Alexa, announce that dinner's ready" to your new Echo Dot and "dinner's ready" will play out in your voice immediately on your other Echo devices.

You can also instantly communicate with other rooms in the house by saying "Alexa, Drop In."

Rename your devices at any time in the Alexa App.

Alexa, announce that dinner is ready.
Alexa, drop in on the Living Room.
Alexa, drop in on the Kitchen.
Alexa, announce that we're leaving in five.

Control your Smart Home

Echo Dot can control many smart home devices, so you can switch on the lamp before getting out of bed, turn on the fan while reading in your favorite chair, or dim the lights from the couch to watch a movie—all without lifting a finger. Just ask:

Alexa, turn on the downstairs lights.
Alexa, lock the front door.
Alexa, set bathroom to 67 degrees.



Alexa Skills

Skills add even more capabilities like ordering pizza from Dominos, requesting a ride from Lyft or Uber, or playing a game of Jeopardy! Simply open the Alexa App, tap "Skills" from the menu, then explore the thousands of skills available. You can also discover skills by voice—just ask, "Alexa, what are your top skills?"

Alexa, Let's play a game. Alexa, What are my skills? Alexa, Help me sleep.



Listen to books

Bring audiobooks to life on your Echo Dot. Start a book on your phone while commuting, and

continue where you left off with Alexa in your kitchen. Listening is easy—just ask:

Alexa, what's free from Audible? Alexa, previous/next chapter. Alexa, stop reading in 30 minutes.
